**CALL FOR ABSTRACTS and SYMPOSIUM TOPICS:** Abstracts will be considered for all topics related to the use of biologic scaffold materials for tissue engineering/regenerative medicine including: fundamental concepts of cell-scaffold interaction, tissue source and processing/manufacturing methods, whole organ engineering with biologic scaffolds, pre-clinical studies of tissue and organ functional repair, tissue processing and manufacturing concepts, regulatory issues, factors that influence the host remodeling response, and results/outcomes of human clinical applications. Abstracts will be considered for podium presentation and poster session display. Approximately 50% of accepted abstracts for podium presentation will relate to clinical outcomes and the remaining 50% will relate to basic science and mechanistic concepts. Deadline for abstracts is December 1, 2024. Notification of abstract decision will be no later than January 15, 2025.
